Class Parents are responsible for:

- Providing a minimum of 10-12 wrapped baskets (valued at approx. \$75 - \$150) to be raffled off at Ramapo's Military Bridge. This year's Military Bridge will be held on Wednesday, October 24th.

If the Class of 2020 does not meet their commitment to Military Bridge, the class will not receive any profits to put toward its Project Graduation.

- Providing Post-Graduation hospitality for the Senior Class (funded by the Senior Class).
- Fundraising to lower the cost of Project Graduation that is passed along to students

Standard Fundraisers during Junior year include: SAT Prep Course (done in collaboration with Indian Hills Class of 2020), Prom Flowers and the Safer Driver Program. Class Parents may supplement with additional fundraisers. For Senior Year, fundraisers include: Senior Parking Spot Raffle (summer between Junior and Senior years), Running Military Bridge, 50/50 Holiday Bonus, Graduation Signs and Senior Prom Flowers.

- Planning and Executing Project Graduation for the Class of 2020.
