The Wyckoff PTO Economy Shop is a non-profit resale/consignment shop that is managed and staffed by 100% volunteers. The shop is open Tuesday – Saturday during the school year and is staffed with short volunteer shifts that vary between 1 ½ - 3 hours long. All net profits from the Shop are distributed to the Wyckoff Public School District as well as Ramapo and Indian Hills. Last year, the Economy Shop donated nearly \$50,000 to our schools!

We are always seeking new in-store shift volunteers because without a properly staffed shift, we cannot open the shop. Volunteer shifts are relatively short and are a great way to support the community and meet new people. It's never been easier to sign-up for a shift by clicking on the link below.
